## SURVEY BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

The Indiana University Southeast Alumni Survey was created in 2012 to obtain data necessary for the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE), the Office of Development, and the Career Development Center. The instrument- found in Appendix A of this report-collects information pertaining to employment, graduate education, preparation for after college, perception of IU Southeast, satisfaction with the college experience, and updated contact information.

## 2018

Respondents for the 2018 survey administration were drawn from institution records of degree recipients and included alumni from the following graduation classes:

- ➤ May 2017, August 2017 and December 2017 graduates (One year out)
- > 2014-2015 graduates (Three years out)
- ➤ 2012-2013 graduates (Five years out; previously surveyed three years out in 2017)

Response rates of the various graduation classes are below. Further demographic details of the respondents are found in the original Alumni Survey reports on the OIE webpage.

## 1. Earth Space and Life Science

Note that respondents' exact answers are listed above. No edits were made to the graduates' words.

#### **PREPAREDNESS**

The majority of responding Secondary Education alumni felt prepared by their IU Southeast education. However, 7% of respondents felt that their preparation was "fair" for finding a job that used skills developed in their major; an additional 7% felt their preparation was "poor." Thirteen percent of respondents felt that their preparation for their most current career and finding a job in their studied field was "fair." Thirteen percent of respondents also felt that their preparation for contributing to their community was "fair;" another 13% felt their preparation was "poor." Finally, 20% of respondents felt that their preparation for furthering their education was "fair" and 7% felt it was "poor."

#### **ADVANCEMENT**

Fourteen of the fifteen Secondary Education alumni achieved at least one of the recognized advancements within 2 years of completing their IU Southeast degree; 53% of achieved two or more; and 27% achieved all three.

## **IU SOUTHEAST EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE**

All of the questions regarding education at IU Southeast received high marks from survey respondents, and disagreement was low. Secondary Education BSED alumni were least likely to agree that they have a civic responsibility to become involved in their community and that they felt like a member of the IU Southeast community. These statements had neutral response rates of 20% and 13%, respectively. Seven percent of respondents also strongly disagreed that they felt like a member of the IU Southeast community.
