# Alumni Survey Special Education BSED

## **Administered June 2019**



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#### SURVEY BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

The Indiana University Southeast Alumni Survey was created in 2012 to obtain data necessary for the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE), the Office of Development, and the Career Development Center. The instrument- found in Appendix A of this report- collects information pertaining to employment, graduate education, preparation for after college, perception of IU Southeast, satisfaction with the college experience, and updated contact information.

#### **Spring 2019**

Respondents for the 2019 survey administration were drawn from institution records of degree recipients and included alumni from the following graduation classes:

- May 2018, August 2018 and December 2018 graduates (One year out)
- > 2015-2016 graduates (Three years out)
- > 2013-2014 graduates (Five years out; previously surveyed three years out in 2017)

Response rates of the various graduation classes are below. Further demographic details of the respondents are found in the original Alumni Survey reports on the OIE webpage.

#### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY**

#### **PREPAREDNESS**

### **General Preparedness**

The majority of responding Special Education BSED alumni felt well prepared by their IU Southeast education in all five of the areas listed below; both one-year out respondents indicated unanimous agreement with all five statements. Only one of the five-years out respondents indicated neither agree nor disagree for all five statements.

### **Specific to Field**

The large majority of responding Special Education BSED alumni also felt well prepared for all of the components evaluated in four critical categories relating to their field: planning and preparation, learning environment, instruction, and professional responsibilities.

For planning and preparation, the majority of respondents agreed with all six statements regarding their preparedness. Again, both one-year out respondents indicated unanimous agreement, while one five-years out respondent indicated neither agree nor disagree for all six statements.

#### RECOMMENDATION

All of the respondents who provided a response to this question indicated that they would recommend IU Southeast to others who wish to pursue teaching careers.

Respondents were also asked to indicate if they would recommend IU Southeast to others who wish to pursue another education degree or license; again, 100% of respondents indicated that they would recommend IU Southeast to others wishing to pursue an additional education degree or license.

Respondents gave the following reasons why in support of their answers:

- 1. IUS did a great job of helping me make connections within the community that in the end helped me get a job.
- 2. It is more affordable than other local schools and you still receive a degree from IU.
- 3. It's a great program with small numbers so students get more individualize instruction
- 4. Once into the cohort, best experience and teachers possible. The program was awesome.
- 5. Wonderful faculty and learning experiences truly prepare for the classroom.

#### PROGRAM STRENGTHS & WEAKNESSES

Respondents were asked if there are any other strengths/weaknesses of their program that they would like to address:

- 1. I currently took on my first student teacher from IUS. I have enjoyed the experience and am looking forward to working more with the education department at IUS.
- 2. I think visual impairments should be discussed more.
- 3. Elementary Reading needs to be better organized. We had a rough couple semesters.
