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SURVEY BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

The Indiana University Southeast Alumni Survey was created in 2012 to obtain data necessary for the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE), the Office of Development, and the Career Development Center. The instrument- found in Appendix A of this report- collects information pertaining to employment, graduate education, preparation for after college, perception of IU Southeast, satisfaction with the college experience, and updated contact information.

Spring 2019

Respondents for the 2019 survey administration were drawn from institution records of degree recipients and included alumni from the following graduation classes:

- May 2018, August 2018 and December 2018 graduates (One year out)
- > 2015-2016 graduates (Three years out)
- > 2013-2014 graduates (Five years out; previously surveyed three years out in 2017)

Response rates of the various graduation classes are below. Further demographic details of the respondents are found in the original Alumni Survey reports on the OIE webpage.

PREPAREDNESS

General Preparedness

Alumni were asked to indicate how well their IU Southeast education had prepared them for five specific areas; their current or most recent career, contributing to their community, furthering their education, finding a job that used skills developed in their major, and finding a job in their studied field. Specific to Field

Alumni were asked to indicate how well their IU Southeast education had prepared them for four critical areas relating to the field of education: planning and preparation, learning environment, instruction, and professional responsibilities. Only two of the five respondents provided responses for this section of questions, and their responses are detailed below:

Preparedness for planning and preparation encompassed the following components: to demonstrate knowledge of content, to demonstrate knowledge of pedagogy, to demonstrate knowledge of students, to set instructional outcomes, to design coherent instruction, and to design student assessment. Both respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they were prepared for each area.

Preparedness for managing the learning environment covered the following components: to create an environment of respect, to establish a culture for learning, to manage classroom procedure, to manage student behavior, and to organize physical space. Both respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they were prepared for each area.

Preparedness for instruction included the following components: to communicate with students, to use questions and discussion techniques, to engage students in learning, to use formative assessment in instruction, to use summative assessment in instruction, and to demonstrate flexibility and responsiveness. Both respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they were prepared for each area.

Finally, preparedness for professional responsibilities comprised of the following components: to communicate with families, to participate in a professional community, to develop professionally, and to show professionalism. Again, both respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they were prepared for each area.

ADVANCEMENT

The five-years out respondent reported achieving all three of the recognized career advancements within two years of graduating, while one of the one-year out respondents reported achieving two.

Levels of satisfaction with emphasized aspects of the IU Southeast experience were also high, with four of the seven areas receiving unanimous satisfaction ratings. However, only one of the three alumnae that provided responses for this series of questions reported that they were satisfied with the opportunities to be involved in extracurricular activities; the other respondents responded with "neutral." Quality of interaction with faculty and quality of information about career and job opportunities also received one response of "neutral" each.

1. I believe it would be good for the university to follow up with students about their career. If struggling to get into their career field for which they received their degree, maybe they can offer some services on interview techniques, as well as helping let the student know about job fairs as well as who is hiring individuals with that specific degree.
