# Alumni Survey Elementary Education MSED

## **Administered June 2019**



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#### SURVEY BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

The Indiana University Southeast Alumni Survey was created in 2012 to obtain data necessary for the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE), the Office of Development, and the Career Development Center. The instrument- found in Appendix A of this report- collects information pertaining to employment, graduate education, preparation for after college, perception of IU Southeast, satisfaction with the college experience, and updated contact information.

### **Spring 2019**

Respondents for the 2019 survey administration were drawn from institution records of degree recipients and included alumni from the following graduation classes:

- May 2018, August 2018 and December 2018 graduates (One year out)
- ➤ 2015-2016 graduates (Three years out)
- > 2013-2014 graduates (Five years out; previously surveyed three years out in 2017)

Response rates of the various graduation classes are below. Further demographic details of the respondents are found in the original Alumni Survey reports on the OIE webpage.

#### **PREPAREDNESS**

### **General Preparedness**

The large majority of responding Elementary Education MSED alumnae felt well prepared by their IU Southeast education, with four of the five areas receiving unanimous agreement ratings. For the area that did not receive unanimous agreement, one respondent rated their preparation to find a job in their studied field as "fair."

### Specific to Field

The large majority of responding Elementary Education MSED alumnae also felt well prepared for the four critical categories relating to their field: planning and preparation, learning environment, instruction, and professional responsibilities.

For planning and preparation, five of the six statements received unanimous agreement from each of the years-out groups. The only area without unanimous agreement was the statement regarding preparation to demonstrate knowledge of students; for this statement, one respondent from the three-years out group indicated that they disagreed.

The large majority of respondents also agreed with the five statements regarding preparing the learning environment, with three of the five statements receiving unanimous agreement from all respondents. Managing student behavior received the lowest agreement rate, with two respondents (17%) neither agreeing nor disagreeing and one respondent disagreeing (8%).

The only statement without unanimous agreement was preparation to use questions and discussion techniques, which had one three-years out respondent indicate disagreement.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Elementary Education MSED respondents were asked to indicate if they would recommend IU Southeast to others who wish to pursue teaching careers. All thirteen respondents indicated that they would recommend IU Southeast to others who wish to purse teaching careers.

Respondents were also asked to indicate if they would recommend IU Southeast to others who wish to pursue another education degree or license; again, all thirteen respondents indicated that they would recommend IU Southeast to others wishing to pursue another education degree or license.

Respondents gave the following reasons in support of their answers:

- 1. Quality coursework close to home, variety of course online and in person
- 2. The education received at IUS is well rounded, and it provides a lot of hands on experience that future teachers need to start their careers as excellent teachers.
- 3. I wish the program was mor rigorous. There are many candidates at my current school, and many seem unprepared with the revised block system.
- 4. I loved the small campus, teacher-student relationships, and instruction.
- 5. I had a good experience with IUS.
- 6. Classes are flexible and affordable. The instructors are knowledgeable and teach current researched methods.
- 7. Not far from home, and the tuition is affordable.

#### PROGRAM STRENGTHS & WEAKNESSES

Respondents were asked if there are any other strengths/weaknesses of their program that they would like to address:

- 1. I feel that the amount of guidance and support that staff lend to the students is a major strength. It was very much appreciated.
- 2. Many candidates lack a sense of urgency and professionalism wanting to be "friends" with students. There have also been times when colleagues of mine have been dissatisfied with a candidates performance, but the IUS supervisor has commented that "was there best lesson". We just need to hold people to high standards. The field of education is struggling right now and we need strong new teachera to help improve matters.
