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SURVEY BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

The Indiana University Southeast Alumni Survey was created in 2012 to obtain data necessary for the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE), the Office of Development, and the Career Development Center. The instrument- found in Appendix A of this report- collects information pertaining to employment, graduate education, preparation for after college, perception of IU Southeast, satisfaction with the college experience, and updated contact information.

Spring 2019

Respondents for the 2019 survey administration were drawn from institution records of degree recipients and included alumni from the following graduation classes:

- May 2018, August 2018 and December 2018 graduates (One year out)
- > 2015-2016 graduates (Three years out)
- > 2013-2014 graduates (Five years out; previously surveyed three years out in 2017)

Response rates of the various graduation classes are below. Further demographic details of the respondents are found in the original Alumni Survey reports on the OIE webpage.

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NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS

Two Secondary Education MSED alumnae responded to the survey: one respondent one-year out from graduation and one respondent five-years out from graduation.

GENDER & AGE

Both respondents were female; one respondent was between ages 20 to 29 and the other was between ages 50 to 59.

EMPLOYMENT & INCOME

Both respondents reported that they had accepted a full-time position since graduating from IU Southeast. The one-year out respondent reported that they accepted their full-time position prior to graduating; however, the five-years out respondent did not indicate when they had accepted their position. Still, both Secondary Education MSED respondents reported that working full-time was their primary status post-graduation.

The one-year out respondent indicated that their current job was in their studied field, while the five-years out respondent declined to provide a response. The one year-out respondent reported earning \$40,001 to \$50,000 per year, while the five-years out respondent again declined to provide a response.

Respondents were asked "What is your guaranteed first-year bonus amount, if you are receiving one?" Their responses are as followed:

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY

The one-year out respondent indicated that they consistently worked while attending IU Southeast, and they generally worked more than 30 hours per week. The five-years out respondent did not indicate whether or not they worked while attending IU Southeast.

Neither respondent indicated participation in any of the five co-curricular activities: completion of a practicum/field experience, participation in community service, participation in a student organization, completion of an internship, or participation in intercollegiate or intramural sports.

POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMS

The one-year out respondent reported having earned a Master's in Secondary Education at IU Southeast, while the five-years out respondent declined to provide a response.

ADDITIONAL LICENSURE

Neither respondent reported completing coursework for an additional license at the time they completed their program.

PREPAREDNESS

General Preparedness

Alumni were asked to indicate how well their IU Southeast education had prepared them for five specific areas; their current or most recent career, finding a job in their studied field, finding a job that used skills developed in their major, contributing to their community, and furthering their education.

The five-years out respondent did not provide answers for this section of questions; however, the one-year out respondent reported that their preparation for all five areas was excellent.

Specific to Field

Alumni were asked to indicate how well their IU Southeast education had prepared them for four critical areas relating to the field of education: planning and preparation, learning environment, instruction, and professional responsibilities.

Preparedness for planning and preparation encompassed the following components: to demonstrate knowledge of content, to demonstrate knowledge of pedagogy, to demonstrate knowledge of students, to set instructional outcomes, to design coherent instruction, and to design student assessment. While the five-years out respondent did not provide responses for this series of questions, the one-year out respondent rated their preparedness for each component as excellent.

Preparedness for managing the learning environment covered the following components: to create an environment of respect, to establish a culture for learning, to manage classroom procedure, to manage student behavior, and to organize physical space. Again, the five-years out respondent did not provide responses for this series of questions; however, the one-year out respondent rated their preparedness for each component as excellent.

Preparedness for instruction included the following components: to communicate with students, to use questions and discussion techniques, to engage students in learning, to use formative assessment in instruction, to use summative assessment in instruction, and to demonstrate flexibility and responsiveness. The one-year out respondent indicated that their preparation for each component was excellent; the five-years out respondent did not provide responses.

Finally, preparedness for professional responsibilities comprised of the following components: to communicate with families, to participate in a professional community, to develop professionally, and to show professionalism. The one year-out respondent once again indicated that their preparation for each component was excellent, whereas the five-years out respondent again did not provide responses.

ADVANCEMENT

The one-year out respondent reported that they achieved all three of the recognized career advancements within two years of graduating.

IU SOUTHEAST EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE

The one-year out respondent agreed or strongly agreed with all seven statements regarding their education at IU Southeast. However, the five-years out respondent left this series of questions blank.
