PROCESS FOR IUS UNDERGRADUATES TO APPLY FOR A KENTUCKY "Statement of Eligibility"

Kentucky issues new teachers a "Statement of Eligibility". This Statement qualifies a person to be hired as a teacher in KY and to participate in the Kentucky Teacher Internship Program. Upon successfully completing the internship, the teacher then applies for a regular license.

All applicants must submit the following materials to the IUS Office of Licensing Advisor:

- An application form for your Statement of Eligibility (TC-1, available from Student Services, HH0029; download at http://www.kyepsb.net/documents/Cert/TC-1_Application.pdf).
- There is <u>no fee</u> for a Statement of Eligibility.
- An official transcript, showing your Education degree. You may ask the Registrar's Office to send it directly to our office (address above).
- Official, passing score reports for all required PRAXIS tests must be on file in the Student Services office before the application can be processed.

You SHOULD NOT Send Your Application Directly to the Kentucky Department of Education

An IU Southeast License Advisor MUST Submit the Application Materials with a recommendation!!!

Please Note: KY does not license teaching minors—only majors. KY does not grant a license for the IN certification area of Physical Science (not enough Chemistry or Physics to be considered a "major" in either).
