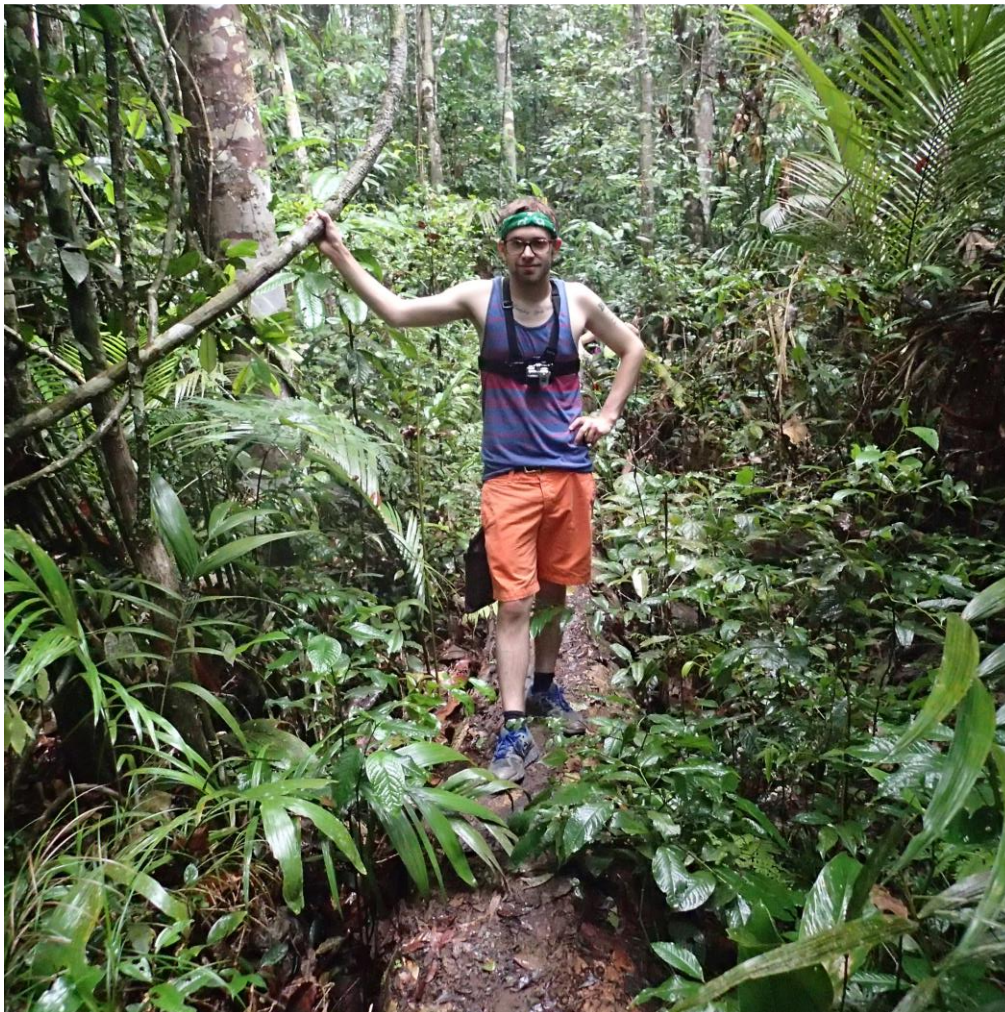
Day Activity
